

# **RESOLUTION OF THE HAWAII REPUBLICAN PARTY IN CONVENTION MAY 18, 2013**

**Whereas** the decades long domination of Hawaii's lawmaking bodies has resulted in many plainly unacceptable conditions;

And **Whereas** we Republicans assembled in statewide representative delegation to elect leaders and consider rules changes find further statement of our resolve on local and nation issues is necessary;


**BE IT RESOLVED** that

- 1) Transparency in government be achieved by the Hawaii legislature applying to itself the same 'sunshine law' it applies to all other governmental bodies;
- 2) The chronic under funding of lawfully required State pension and medical plans be promptly corrected by regular equal payments into the funds so as to achieve solvency within 30 years, and that if the amount required be found unaffordable without raising taxes that either a) other State expenses be reduced, or b) a constitutional amendment be placed before the people to allow a change in the previously negotiated pension and medical commitments so as to create solvent plans in accord with accepted principles of the actuary profession;
- 3) Road resurfacing and repair no longer be subject to diversion by State or County governments of fuel tax and other highway maintenance dedicated funds to other purposes, and that such receipts be spent on an accelerated and persistent program of road rebuilding and repair to higher standard for greater durability and usefulness.
